Local Rules

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1)

- On or beyond the road at the first hole.
- Beyond any fence or wall bounding the course.
- Beyond the line of white stakes bounding the 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th and 18th (not the right side of the 18th)

2. Walls - All remaining walls are integral parts of the course.

3. Grounds Under Repair (Rule 25) - If a ball comes to rest in an area marked by

- a GUR sign, b) an enclosed white line, c) marked by blue posts, relief MUST be taken.

4. Young Staked Trees (Rule 24-2b (1)) - If such a tree interferes with the player's stance or intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed.

5. All Paths and Roads - All are integral parts of the course, with exception of the buggy tracks at the 12th and 17th where relief may be taken.

6. Tractor Marks (Rule 25-1b) - A player whose ball is lying in a tractor mark may obtain relief.

7. Distance Markers (Rule 24-2) - Relief for interference by them may be obtained.

8. Stones in Bunkers (Rule 24-1) - Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions.

9. Bridges (Rule 24-2) - A ball coming to rest on any part(s) of a bridge outwith the hazard, relief may be taken.

Distance Markers

A disk in the fairway and green posts with two white rings mark 150 yards to the centre of the green.

Penalty Breach of Local Rule

Match Play - Loss of hole. Stroke Play - Two strokes.

Suspension of Play

One blast on the Klaxon.

Cancellation of Play

Two loud blasts on the Klaxon.

PLEASE AVOID SLOW PLAY
